A summary of the results is shown below.

	Condition A (mobile phones off in the classroom)	Condition B (mobile phones on in the classroom)
Mean	7	5
Mode	7	7
Median	7	4
Range	5	3

- (c) Analyse the mean scores of this experiment in relation to the aim of the research.
